

Wombeyan Caves 4/07/10 – Information Sheet.

Details regarding day visit to Wombeyan Caves on 4th July, 2010:

Meet at Catholic Club: call leader for time.

We will travel to the caves via Goulburn (toilet / coffee stop), Taralga (toilet stop if needed) and Richlands. This route is approximately 250km (one way) with an 11km section of dirt road. Once at the caves, we will complete the loop walk to Tinted Cave (for morning tea) via the Mares Forest Creek Track (two creek crossings), Junction Track to Junction Caves and return. On the return we will complete the self guided tour of Fig Tree Cave which is absolutely spectacular (and highly recommended) but requires a token for entry (Adults: \$15, Seniors: \$13.50, Pensioners: \$10).

Once back at the carpark we can make use of the facilities for a wonderful lunch. Available at the site: fully equipped camp kitchen with two electric bbqs (requires 20c coins), a microwave, sinks, electric urn for hot water, fully enclosed dining room with tables and chairs should the weather be inclement, ample picnic spots, toilets. There is also a kiosk providing light snacks / refreshments.

If time permits, a short afternoon walk to the marble quarry, Wombeyan Falls, or other nearby caves.

Depending on the drivers / cars available on the day, return could be via Goulburn or Mittagong (but this is almost 50km of dirt road and although route is 100km shorter overall it will take the same time as the alternative). It would be appreciated if those volunteering to drive on the day could let me know when they call to book in.

Expect to contribute up to \$17 per person for petrol (depending on numbers per vehicle) + cost of entry to cave.

This will be a full day and return will be around 5-6pm.
